



Finnish Championships Sprint Orienteering Competition Saturday 19.9.2020 in Salo, Finland

World Ranking Event (WRE)

Important notes

- When arriving to the event center, follow the given instructions! Do not traverse through competition/forbidden area!
- Number bibs are in the event center. A-finals use new number bibs, B-finals use the same bib as in qualification. Bring your own safety bins.
- **Qualification** starting at 9:00, only in classes M/W21, H/D20 and H/D18. Qualification start = **start 3**, distance 2400 meters. There are toilets in the start and also a possibility to leave your clothes to be transported back to the event center.
- **Finals** starting at 12:00. **Start 1** (classes H/D14-21, H35-65 and D35-50) distance 1750 meters. In start 1 there are toilets and also a possibility to leave your clothes to be transported back to the event center. **Start 2** (classes H70-85 and D55-85) distance to waiting area 750m, where there are toilets and room to warm up. You can move from the start 2 waiting area to the start 10 minutes before your own start time.
- Control descriptions are handed out in start and also printed on the map.

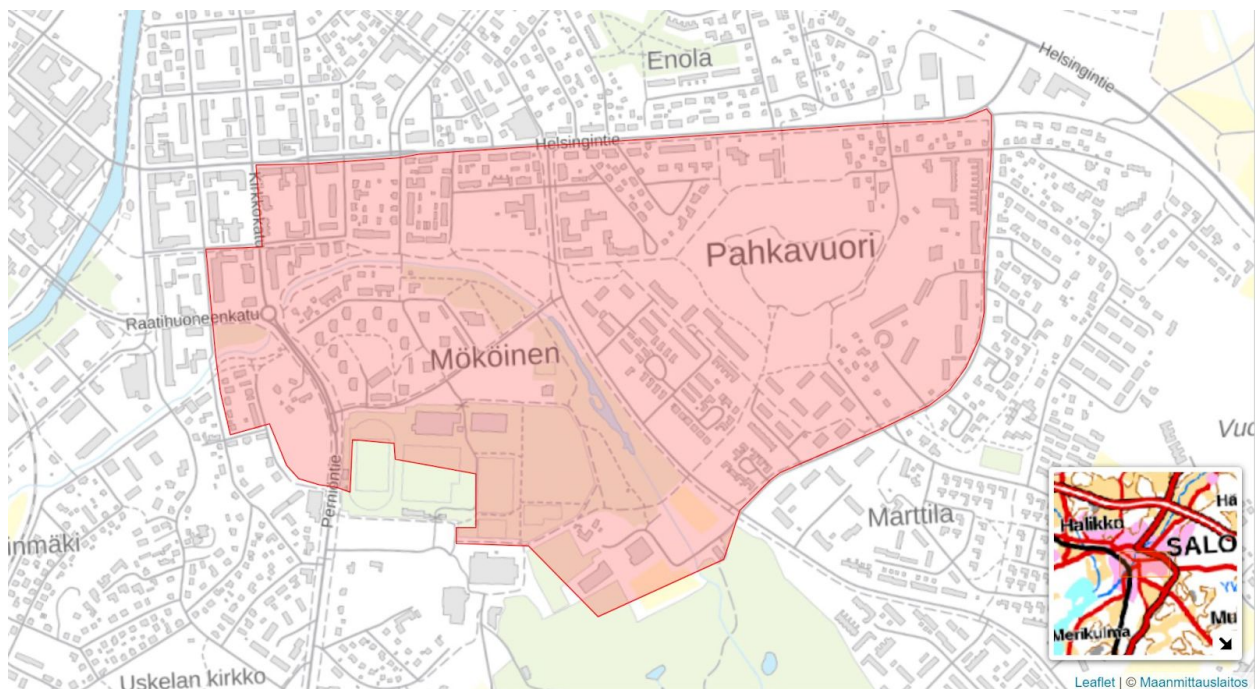

Rules

The rules of the Finnish Orienteering Federation (16.6.2020-) as well as instructions given by the organizer and the International Orienteering Federation will be applied in the competition.

Event center and forbidden area

Event center is located in Salon urheilupuisto. The event center opens at 7:00 on the morning of the competition. When arriving to the event center, follow the given instructions! Do not traverse through competition/forbidden area (see updated area below)! The arrival maps can be found from [the competition web site](#).



Parking & arrival

Signposts from south / Helsinki direction: Mahtinaisentie southern intersection (Navigator-address: Perniöntie 311, Salo), and from North / Turku direction: intersection of roads 110 and Meriniityntie (Navigator-address: Meriniityntie 1, Salo). Signposts in place from 7:00.

Walking distance to event center max 1.5 km.

Competition center can also be reached by walking or by bike from the Salo city center, as long as one does not traverse through the embargoed area.

Please note that the parking areas next to the event center are forbidden to use for the competitors. They are reserved for the use of other events.

Info

Info opens at 8:00. Rental emit cards and emit card number changes can be done in the info. It is possible to leave valuables for safekeeping into info for the duration of the competition.

Signpost is located next to the Info.

Start 3. Distance to start is 2400 meters. Red-yellow signage. WC and clothing transport 2050 meters from competition center.

Start 1. Distance to start is 1750 meters. Blue-yellow signage. WC and clothing transport 1600 meters from competition center.

In classes H55, H60 and H65 scale is 1:3000 and map size A3. Other classes have scale 1:4000 and map size A4.

Punching system

Emit punching system will be in use. The competitor is responsible for using a working emit card, and that the emit card number is the same as in the start list. Competitor who runs with a wrong emit card will be disqualified.

Emit card changes possible until Friday 18.9. 20:00 to [risto.kivinen\(at\)resultfellows.com](mailto:risto.kivinen@resultfellows.com). After this, to the Info at the event center. Emit cards can also be rented from the Info for the price of 5€. Unreturned emit card will induce a 70 € fee.

Emit card can be tested at a sample control close to the Info.

Number bibs and emit safety slips

Number bibs are in the event center, in folders by the class. Located close to the Info. Use hand sanitizer before picking up your bib.

A-finals use new number bibs, and these can be collected soon after the qualification results are finalized. B-finals use the same bib as in qualification. Bring your own safety bins.

Emit safety slips are available at the starts.

Procedure at the start

The way to the start goes through city area. Be aware of other traffic and use pedestrian crossings. It is forbidden to stray away from the signed way to the start.

Use hand sanitizer before moving into the start zone.

3 min: Call to start zone by start time. Control descriptions.

2 min: Emit formatting (0-punching unit).

1 min: Moving to map basket of own class. Make sure you are by the right map basket.

0 min: Start.

Control descriptions

Control description are handed out in the start and also printed on the map.

Clothing transport

There is a possibility to leave your clothes to be transported back to the event center from starts 1 and 3. **No clothing transport from start 2.**

Bring your own bag for clothes. Clothes can be picked up from the event center.

Finish

Competitors punch at the finish line, after which they will directly continue to emit card reading.

After the finish, the competitor will leave his/her map to a designated container (to lessen the risk of corona infections). Maps will not be returned but can be printed from the event web site after the competition.

Map

Sprint orienteering map, printed 9/2020. Map maker: Vesa Elovaara. Scale: H/D55- 1:3000, other classes 1:4000. Map size A4-A3.

New ISSprOM 2019 symbols are used in the competition. Be precise with forbidden areas and symbols. There will be a sample map in the start featuring the forbidden symbols and colors. Competition map won't be shown before the start.

- Kartan mittakaava on 1:4000. Myös suurennos 1:3000 on luvallinen ja mahdollinen.
- Taajama-alueilla kannattaa välttää 60 % vihreän värin käyttöä, että läpipääsemätön 100 % vihreä olisi mahdollisimman selkeästi erilainen ja erottuva.

Terrain

Qualification: Living neighborhood, parks, and some good surfaced forest. 60 % grass, 30 % hard surface and 10 % paths or forests.

Finals: Typical varied city area with parks and build environment. 70 % hard surface, 30 % grass.

Terrain guards and forbidden areas

There are about 60 guards in the terrain making sure of the safety and that rules are followed. The guards will not advise the runners unless a real danger is about to emerge. If a competitor breaks the rules, a guard will make a disqualification proposal. The breaking of the rules cannot be reversed by the competitor, for example, if a competitor crosses a forbidden vegetation, it cannot be fixed by returning the same route (and doing the same error again). Same applies for all other forbidden symbols and areas. Some of the forbidden areas / symbols are marked in the terrain with red-yellow forbidden area marking.

In both qualification and finals, all competitors will need to cross a forbidden road via crossing point (marked on map). The crossing points are marked on the terrain with small barrels on both sides of the road at the crossing point. The road must be crossed between those barrels. Breaking this rule will lead to disqualification.

The finish will be closed at 11:07 after the qualification, and at 16:45 after the finals. The finish can be closed earlier if all competitors have finished. Those who do not finish, must report in at the finish.

Complaints

Possible complaints must be made according to the rules: WRE-classes 15 minutes, and other classes 30 minutes after the competition has ended. Qualification and finals are two different competitions. Complaints must be done in written form and delivered to the Info in the given deadlines.

Price giving

At the event center. More information at the event center. Follow the speakers.

No prices are given in the B-finals.

In the official Finnish championships results are included eligible runners according to the rules of the Finnish Orienteering Federation.

GPS-tracking

Club tents

There are several warmed fields in the event center area. Hence, club tents can only be set up inside a designated area (east edge of the event center).

Café and restaurants

There is no café / restaurant at the event center run by the organizer. There are several options available in the city of Salo, many not far from the event center. If using these services during the competition day, make sure you do not violate embargoed area.

Dressing rooms, showers and toilets

There are 8 dressing rooms each with 6 showers in the event center.

There are toilets in the event center. Follow the signs.

First aid

In the event center. According to the competition rules, an injured runner must be helped during the competition.
